

# Notice to all members who attend classes at the Community Centre

A Security Officer will be manning the front door of the Community Centre and you will not be allowed to enter the building unless you have authority to do so.

This means, <u>you will be required to wear your</u>

<u>Badge</u> to identify yourself as a U3A member attending a class.

# Notice about general class hygiene procedures

For the moment <u>we cannot carry on our usual tea, coffee and biscuits formalities and crowding around in the office area</u>. Please observe notices about how to enter office area, as posted outside the door. And, sorry, no midtime coffee breaks – buy it before and bring it in, if you want it.

Your Tutor will have a set of instructions on how to leave the class room hygienically clean for use by the next class coming into the room. <u>Classes will generally finish earlier than usual</u> to achieve this.

It will be <u>expected all students will help to clean the</u> <u>room after class</u> and that this task will not be left to just one or a few. Everyone has a responsibility towards this, as we are committed to fulfil Government Health Rules in the wellbeing of all our members.

# Expect this from your tutor...

Each Tutor will be issued a current Class Attendance Sheet. It will be the Tutor's responsibility to mark off the role of class attendees themselves. (Thus if the class habit is simply to send the roll around the room, we cannot continue this, because we have to know exactly who is in any class at any time. Attendance Sheets need to be given to the Health Department, if we have someone who attends U3A who then tests positive.

Tutors, please be vigilant & make sure no-one is put at risk. Tutors should ask:

- 1 Has anyone travelled interstate in the last 14 days?
- 2 Does anyone have a cough or sore throat?
- 3 Does anyone have a temperature?

# **Basic things to remember**

- Covid must now play a part in how we do things.
   Vigilance is ultra important.
- Remember that if anyone answers 'yes' to any of the above 3 questions, they must stay at home & self-isolate and/or get tested.
- All classes must comply with "Social Distancing" and Sanitising rules.
- U3A will supply sanitiser & wipes.
- USE OF MASKS: At this point there is no compulsory use of facial masks. (But circumstances may force changes, so be prepared.) And, if a member wishes to wear a mask, please feel free to do so.
- Tutors must cut their classes at least a little short, not only to put things away as usual to make it easier for the next class to start on time, but also in order to have your class properly 'sanitise' the classroom & furniture for the classes following.
- REMEMBER TO ALWAYS SANITISE YOUR HANDS
