President's Message

When we were deeply in the lockdown, and even felt that we would not be able to open up again this year, it was decided that as many people had missed out on classes, we would reduce the payments when it came round to Renewals. Sadly, during this time, we had flooding at Margaret Street on two occasions and needed roof repairs urgently, which unfortunately took up a lot of our funds.

As you are all aware, we are a "non profit" organisation, and as such rely on membership fees to pay all the bills, such as electricity, rental for classes at the Community Centre (which is one of our biggest costs), phone bills, rent (peppercorn though it is), rent on the printers, stationery, maintenance and all the expenses of running an office.

Without the membership payments coming in, U3A would have to close down, which I am sure you don't want, and at the General Meeting on 17th September at the Community Centre, there was a lot of discussion about the pros and cons of the payments staying as they are e.g. \$45 if members join now till the end of the year, and \$75 for Renewals, commencing on 1st November for the end of 2021. Of course, if you have problems paying this amount, we will certainly listen to you and reduce the amount if you feel you cannot pay it. We are always there to listen to you.

The Volunteers will be working very hard, preparing class lists, and doing all the paperwork which is necessary to run our office efficiently. We have had three new volunteers who are being trained for the front office and we thank them sincerely. Also we thank the Tutors who do such a wonderful job.




