Message from the Class Coordinator

Following requests from some members who are anxious to have their class start earlier than 3 August, it is not until we can get things reorganised at the Community Centre and the okay from the Health Department, that we cannot have some classes go ahead while others sit in abeyance – no favours be given.

How things stand at the moment:

 Extract from the Gold Coast City Council's Community Centres - June update:

"In mid-July the maximum of 100 people per venue has been removed however social distancing directions to maintain one person for every 4 m2 up to 7 people per 7 m2 for more active activities. Until we know more about what restrictions look like after Stage 3, it's not anticipated that Community Centres will be able to host larger events until further notice."

The Community Centre has released new standards to fulfil contact tracing and other requirements.

- Margaret Street classes should not to be be cut down in size.
- Study Room classes to be assessed.

Overall, 'physical distancing' is the main concern and will dictate maximum numbers in classes.

However, further restrictions may be lifted as we get closer to start of Semester 2, but hand sanitizing and hygiene practices will remain together with cleaning after each class will be required.

Currently, the Management Committee is liaising with the relevant parties to meet the new standards and ensure your safe return to U3A.
